Columbus will be in good hands as our former manager will step in:) The Cleveland event coming Oct. 27-29 is registering very well at this point with close to 100 registrations. We had a great team meeting on April 15th. The couple I featured in last month's letter is now on the team! They are on fire and spreading the word in their church. Our last trip took us to Cincinnati. Their team is making plans to help get more churches involved with a plan to visit churches and let them know FamilyLife is here to help them. Both our Columbus and Cincinnati teams are very well experienced in doing small groups and they and we love seeing folks growing in their marriages and want to help more in this way. If all goes as planned Jane and I hope to start a grandparenting group in fall. Overall for FamilyLife there have been over 29,000 in attendance this spring which is 105% of our goal!!!! For us it's getting through this blood cancer which so far is going well. I'm typing this on DAY ONE of my 100 day restriction protocol. My immune system is wiped and my son's stem cells are trying to navigate to take place in my bone marrow. I am doing some journaling while here and sharing the simple gospel. The medical field is also on mission and I get to help by doing 3 sets of marrow images that will help others in the future. The hard part about these pics is that I have to be perfectly still/strapped down for 40+ minutes. I am the 24th candidate for this. I hope to get an 8x10 autographed pic :) A stone of remembrance.

- Prayer: By June I will be over the hurdle of the battle going on in my body and my body will accept Dan's cells and my counts will make their way back up so I can go home. It will be a long journey back to "normal" but then I'll be like new!
